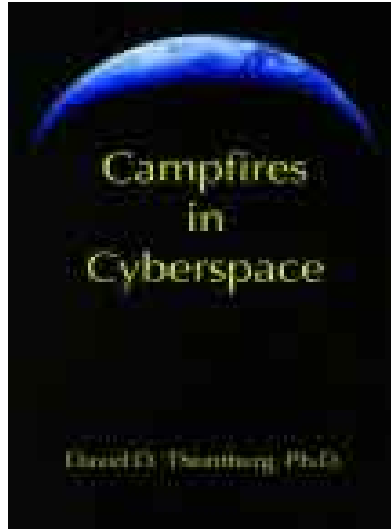


Campfires in Cyberspace
